The Care Management Tracking System (CMTS) is a HIPAA-compliant web application that supports the core principles of effective integrated care. It is ideal for research studies or contexts that span multiple healthcare organizations with specific tracking/reporting needs. More information about CMTS can be found on the <u>AIMS Center's website</u>. Healthcare organizations must sign a license and make UW their business associate in order to use CMTS.
